What To Wear

This has to be the number one question that we receive from families. You really locked the session - how to plan the outfit! Don't stress yourself out! While our outfits are fun, at the end of the day, it's really about your family and the connections that are captured - not the clothes.

Here are a few pointers though to get you started:

1. The rule of thumb is to pick a color and then stick to similar tones within that color palette. We have also provided you with some additional color options to the right!
2. Don't wear matching clothes and colors. You don't do this a "lot" lol... and we want to capture your family as natural as you can!
3. Be comfortable. This should be fun for you and your kids. There were no kids of rolling around in the grass, running, jumping and playing!

Photo tips to get better snapshots!



When you're taking a photo, it's important to get the lighting right. The best time to take a photo is when the sun is low in the sky. This means that you can get a soft, natural light.
